Hooded jumpers, denim, thongs/ sandals are not acceptable items to be worn to school. Please note leggings are not appropriate wear for school, unless worn under shorts or a skirt. Metal facial piercings are not acceptable at school

Students are required to wear their school uniform when travelling to and from school, on all excursions and when attending exams.

Procedure for Students without uniform

- If students are having uniform difficulties they need to attend Student Services before school to have a discussion re uniform.
- If students arrive at class completely out of uniform without a note from Student Services, class teacher will send immediately to Student Services. Year Coordinators / Managers will contact home and follow procedures
- Class teachers will mark if students if have incorrect uniform
- Year Coordinators will monitor uniform and students may loose their Good Standing if they continue to not follow school uniform policy and procedure
